Director, Rates & Regulatory Affairs

Directs the administrative and functional activities of the El Paso Eastern Pipeline System Rates & Regulatory Affairs department. Responsible for the coordination of response to regulatory agencies' requirements on rate and certificate matters; assumes compliance with rulings and regulations.

Manager, Rates

Manages the coordination, preparation and regulatory approval of rate and tariff filings for the El Paso Eastern Pipeline System.

Director, Regulatory Affairs

Incumbent develops regulatory strategies, advises on related regulatory policies concerning critical projects and related services, and directs the preparation of all FERC certificate, abandonment, tariff, and reporting filings for the El Paso Western Pipeline Systems.

Manager, Tariff

Oversees tariff filings, Transportation Service Agreements, conducts regulatory research, calculates rate refunds, and provides tariff recommendations.

Analyst, Regulatory-Principal

Prepares regulatory filings, reviews transportation service agreements and open seasons, conducts regulatory research, and monitors FERC activities.

Analyst, Regulatory-Senior

Incumbent prepares tariff filings to be submitted to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") that are necessary to comply with FERC regulations and to accomplish the Company's business goals; conducts regulatory research and provides management with alternatives and recommendations as to the implementation of FERC policy; works to ensure Company compliance with Order 2004.

Analyst, Regulatory

Prepares regulatory filings for submittal to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission that are necessary to comply with FERC Regulations and to accomplish the Company's business goals

Manager, Certificates & Regulatory Policy

Responsible for the major certificates filings and regulatory reporting/compliance for the Western Pipelines.

Director, Rates

Responsible for the development, filing and prosecution of all rate related matters for the El Paso Western Pipeline System. Directs all internal economics ensuring compliance with corporate objectives and strategic values.

Manager, Rates

Responsible for initial preparation of all cost of service studies including new project analysis in support of business development and general rate cases. Extensive interaction with FERC Staff including preparation and delivery of testimony before the FERC, in both written and oral form for the El Paso Western Pipeline System.

Analyst, Rate-Principal

Coordinates and leads team efforts related to all aspects of rates, and provides analytical support to the rate processes.

Analyst, Rate-Senior

Provides analytical support to the entire rate process.

Manager, Rates

Manages the activities associated with rate analysis, rate design, and rate filings. Also will prepare competitive rate analyses. Develops all economic analysis for capital projects and or transportation contracts for the El Paso Western Pipeline System.

Consultant, Planning & Rates

Responsible for addressing high level rate-related items and representing Western Pipelines in the negotiations associated with FERC technical and settlement conferences. Provides testimony at FERC hearings and leads third party rate discussions. Also develops rate case and settlement strategy, rate testimony, and is responsible for cost allocation and rate design analysis.

Director, Rates

Incumbent directs the administrative and functional activities of SNG and Southern LNG's Rates department. Responsibilities include the coordination of response to regulatory agencies' requirements on rate and certificate matters; assumes compliance with rulings and regulations. Provides competitive analysis and rate and economic analyses for expansion and Greenfield projects.

Consultant, Planning & Rates

Responsible for developing gas and power demand/supply forecast for the southeast. Performs extensive analysis, evaluation, project development alternatives and recommendations.
